The Transition Process

Conferencing between Middle School teachers/counselors/nurses/specialists and their partners at KHS occur throughout the spring. It has already begun!

Parents can ask questions and talk to middle school teachers about anything (schedule, timing of events, class recommendations, etc.) in the coming months. (Spring conferences)

- •Recommended for students in Geometry, Honors Geometry or higher in 9th grade
- There is no weight or honors designation to this class


