Breakfast and/or Lunch

Meals are no longer free to all children under 18 in the community. Please fill out an application to see if your family qualifies for free or reduced meal benefits. Click here to access the application for free or reduced meal benefits.

The Kirkwood School District's Food Service Operation is modeled to be financially self-sustaining with the goal to break even. It is the District's goal to ensure that all students have access to fairly priced, quality, safe, nutritious, tasty, and balanced meals that meet or exceed the USDA guidelines.

Robinson Elementary is nut free. In an effort to support our students with food allergies, please pack a nut free lunch and snack. All lunches purchased at school are also nut free. We have many students with airborne allergens and this puts them at risk of a reaction. We want to be able to ensure all students' safety while on campus and during transportation. If your child has a snack or lunch item that contains nuts, they will not be allowed to eat it on campus and we will send it back home. We have nut free replacement items that will be given to the child instead. Please do your part to ensure the safety of all of our students. Thank you for your consideration for the children who are at risk. We appreciate your compliance with our food safety measures.

My School Bucks

The Kirkwood School District expanded the use of My School Bucks, which was used for online lunch payments, to include iPad and laptop insurance fees, activity fees, etc.

- If you currently have a My School Bucks account, you can log in and access the school store at the top of the page.
- If you do not have a My School Bucks account, you may create a free account. You will need each student's identification number to create accounts.
- To pay for iPad or laptop insurance, lunch fees, and activity fees through your MySchoolBucks.com account:
 - Log in to MySchoolBucks.com or create a free account.
 - Click School Store at the top of the page and select Browse All Items
 - Choose the Store Item and add it to your cart
 - Check out!

Parents can also download the MySchoolBucks app to set up an account and make payments. Those who prefer not to use our online payment option can pay via cash or check, working directly with Robinson.

Dropping off Lunches and Other Student Items

If you need to drop something off for your child (lunch, jacket, etc.), ring the front bell. Front office staff will admit you into the building. Come to the front office and drop off any materials your child may need.

General Visitor Instructions

- Visitors will be permitted inside of school buildings. All visitors will need to adhere to the health
 and safety protocols in place for staff and students. All visitors must check in with the front office
 staff and have their driver's license run through our security system to verify that they are safe to
 be on campus.
- Visitors will not be allowed to visit lunch unless it is during a designated Fun Friday school event. Please check the school calendar to view our Fun Friday dates and times.

Outdoors

Robinson is very fortunate to have such a large campus that affords a large number of classes to learn and break outside throughout the day. We will get students outside as much as possible even when the weather starts to turn just a bit. Please send in appropriate clothing and consider layers so your student can work comfortably outside. We also do all we can to keep classroom windows open.

Recess

Students will have a 25 minute recess daily prior to lunch time. When weather does not permit outdoor recess, indoor recess will be held and supervised by support staff.

Specials Classes

We will follow an <u>ABCD specials rotation</u>. Classroom specials schedule can be found <u>here</u>. Your child's class will follow the same schedule all year.

ARRIVAL PROCEDURES

Students should not be left unattended at the front door or OLC or anywhere on campus without a parent staying with them to supervise until 8:25 am. Thank you.

Car Drop Off

- Drive around the back of the building to the side by the field.
- There will be 2 car lanes for drop off. 1 staff member will direct cars into 2 lanes, 1 staff member will hold the cars until students exit, and 2 staff members will help students exit the cars.
- Students can begin exiting their cars at 8:25 am, when directed by a staff member.

Building Entrance for Car Drop Off


• Students will enter through the laundry room or art hallway doors. Students will then either pick up breakfast or head to the classroom.

Walkers and Bike Riders

 Students should arrive at 8:25-8:35 if they are walkers or bikers. They should use the same entrances as car drop off. Students will either go to the cafe for breakfast or head to the classroom.

Bus Riders

 As buses arrive, staff members will greet each bus and dismiss the students to enter the building. Students will proceed to the cafe to pick up breakfast or head to the classroom. **Arrival Map**

Dismissal Procedures

Car Pick Up

You will need to make a car card to place on your dashboard. You need to put your child's last name on the top center of the card in large and bold writing. Then put your child(ren)'s first name(s) below. If you are picking up children with two different last names, please make a separate card for each different last name.

When you arrive, please pull around the back of the building and wait for a staff member to direct you to a row. Have your paper card on your dashboard where we can easily view it. A staff member will direct you to one of the 5 designated rows where cars wait until students arrive and all cars are loaded. Once cars are parked, students will be released and loaded into the cars. Once your child is secured in the vehicle and all cars in the row are ready, a staff member will direct your row to pull forward and exit the lot.

Walkers & Bike Riders

Walkers and bike riders will be dismissed once all buses and cars are cleared. They will exit the doors closest to them with their teacher and walk to the OLC or the bike rack to get their bikes or meet their parents at the OLC.

Bus Riders

Bus riders will be dismissed as the buses arrive.

Attendance Procedures

- If your child will be tardy or absent from school, please notify the office as soon as possible by calling 314.213.6140 and selecting option 1. You can leave a message in our attendance voicemail box. Or, you may email an absence to <u>robinsonattendance@kirkwoodschools.org</u>. If your child is absent from school and we have not heard from you, we will call you to verify your child's absence.
- As per KSD policy, part of our responsibilities at school is to monitor and keep families notified of how many days students miss and/or are late to school, regardless of the reason. Our goal is to have 95% of students here 95% of the time. That means fewer than 5% of students have 10+ absences. There is research around the 10 day target and this is also a district expectation. Every week, we run attendance and tardy reports and begin to notify parents of absences of 5, 10, or 15+ days, again regardless of reasons. We also notify families of excessive tardies. This is just a notification. If we have bigger concerns, we will be reaching out and offering support. And it goes both ways. If you receive a letter stating higher than expected tardies or absences and need assistance or problem solving, please call our school counselors.

Signing Students In if They Are Late

• If your student arrives at school after 8:40 am, they will be marked tardy. If your student arrives between 8:40 am - 9:00 am, they will need to sign in at the office. After 9:00 am, you will need to come into the office to sign your student in.

Signing Students Out During School Hours

If you need to sign your child out of school during the school day, call the office at 314-213-6140
and let us know you are on your way. When you arrive, ring the bell and the office staff will buzz
you into the office to sign your child out. Please tell anyone that is signing your child out to be
prepared to show identification.

Student birthdays will be celebrated with 15 Minutes of Fame. For student safety, we are requiring

Building & Facility Usage
