- **Principal's Update**

- **Strategic plan:** Surveys to come to gauge where we are with our goals as a school. Parents survey will take 12-15 min.
- **Construction:** Trailer, fencing, and temporary parking lot are all in place. Dr. Ricker will have biweekly meetings on progress for the project. Rebar should be coming in next week and then they can start pouring the foundation. All contingent on supplies and weather for completion.
