### Halloween Parade & Parties

We are excited to welcome visitors for our Halloween parade and parties on Tuesday. Please read below for several important logistics. As a reminder, adjustments to our plans were made to allow for the greatest number of students to feel comfortable



participating and ensure that any family member who wants to view the parade is be able to do so in a safe and secure manner.

#### Viewing the Parade

- Rather than starting in front of Tillman and parading through the neighborhood, we will meet behind the school and parade around the perimeter of our back campus. The parade will begin at 2:20.
- Family members who'd like to line the new parade route must first be cleared for campusaccess through our <u>Raptor Visitor Management System</u>, just as they would if accessing a classroom in our building.
- We strongly encourage anyone wishing to view the parade to pre-register using this form.
- Guests who have pre-registered can check in between 1:45-2:20 to receive their pre-printed name tags. Checkin will be outside, at the entrance to the new back parking lot (located east of our new wing). As an FYI, 230 guests have pre-registered as of Sunday morning.
- Those who have NOT pre-registered will need to enter the building through the front center doors, signing in through the office before heading to the back of the building.
- Please bring your license/ID if you plan to attend, whether you pre-register or not.
- After the parade, we ask all visitors to exit through the parking lot and return your badges before leaving campus.

#### **Party Information**

- Only parents who previously signed up through PTO to run parties will have access to our classrooms for the event. These parents/guardians will also be required to Raptor onto campus and can pre-register at this link.
- ALL party volunteers, including those who pre-register, are asked to enter the building through the front center doors and check-in before going to the classrooms. We will have visitor badges printed and ready for those who have pre-registered.
- Please bring your license/ID if you plan to attend, whether you pre-register or not.

#### **Additional Details**

 Please do not send students to school in costumes, as they will be given time to change at school before the parade. Students should be able to change easily and independently into their costumes at school. We strongly discourage excessively violent or gory costumes and makeup. "Weapons" of any kind...swords, toy guns, toy knives, etc. must remain at home.

Masks are okay as long as they are not gory and don't impair student's sight as they're walking in the parade.


- Students who do not feel comfortable participating in the parade will have the option to view a Halloween video in the gymnasium before transitioning back to their classrooms for parties.

# Safe & Inclusive Spaces

The following information was also included in the Oct 15 Update, the date of our Trunk or Treat event. Families may have understandably missed this information, and our book studies were necessarily postponed. We are prepared to begin these important conversations with students this week, continuing them through November.

We are deeply committed to creating spaces that are safe and inclusive for each student. This means directly confronting racist, hateful, and hurtful language when it occurs. Unfortunately, we have seen an increase in the use of racial slurs this year, specifically the n-word.

The children's book *Our Skin* begins with the following introduction: 'Young children notice a lot - including skin color, race, and even injustice and racism. It can be hard to find the right words to answer their questions or to start a conversation about race. But when we don't talk about it, children often come to their own conclusions, which can include bias and stereotypes because of



the world we live in. Simple conversations can help make sense of their world and even recognize and speak up about injustice.'

Starting Monday, we are beginning a four week, school-wide book study to discuss belonging and racism with our students. The entire school will hear the same read-aloud on morning announcements each week, and then classroom teachers will facilitate age-appropriate discussions centered around the same question. Over the course of four weeks, staff and students will read *A Kids Book About Belonging, Our Skin, A Kids Book About Racism*, and an excerpt from *Antiracist Kid*.

All students will hear <u>A Kids Book About Belonging</u> this week, discussing the question, "What can you do to make everyone feel they belong at Tillman?" Families can help reinforce this message at home by talking to your Trailblazer about honoring the dignity of individuals — and rejecting hate. In addition to the link above, a resource that may be helpful is <u>Beyond the Golden Rule</u>, from Learning for Justice, which includes information about how to help kids foster a community of belonging and treat others with respect. We will continue to update families each week, with links to the upcoming book and our discussion question. If you have any questions, please contact <u>Mr. Hoover</u> or <u>Dr. Painter</u>.


