# Safe & Inclusive Spaces, Week Three

Tillman began a four week, school-wide book study last month to discuss belonging and racism with our students. The entire school hears the same read-aloud on morning announcements each week, and then classroom teachers facilitate age-appropriate discussions centered around the same question. This work is necessary, at least in part, to address an unfortunate increase we've seen in the use of racial slurs and hurtful language.



- Our first read aloud was <u>A Kids Book About Belonging</u>, with all classes discussing the question, "What can you do to make everyone feel they belong at Tillman?"
- Our second read aloud was <u>Our Skin</u>, with all classes discussing the question, "How do we honor every individual at Tillman?"
- This week all students will hear the book <u>A Kids Book About Racism</u> and discuss the question, "How does racism make it harder to belong?"
- Our final read aloud, next week, will be an excerpt from Antiracist Kid.

### **Trunk or Treat Follow Up**

It's hard to believe, in many ways, that it's been nearly a month since our Trunk or Treat event. While most things at school have returned to normal, we understand that the events of October 15 continue to impact our kids, teachers, and families in different ways.

- As we move into the holiday season, it's important to remember that kids and adults may be
  affected by seemingly "normal" sounds, such as fireworks, popping champagne/wine corks,
  and popping balloons. Preparing for the possibilities of these sounds, and the feelings they
  could trigger, may be helpful to you and your children especially if your family was at the
  event.
- If you'll be with family or in large-group settings during the holidays, it's possible that others
  may ask how you're doing and/or naturally be curious about details of the event. You may
  want to think in advance about how you'll handle any such questions, particularly if you'd
  prefer not to talk about your experience and/or feelings. If you'd prefer the event not be
  discussed with or around your children, it may be smart to share this with your loved ones in
  advance.
- If you need immediate support on an individual level, you can still reach out directly to Behavioral Health Response for a virtual or home appointment. They provide crisis support, telephone counseling and mental health resources 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. They can be reached at 314-469-6644 (emergency response) or 314-628-6204 (non-emergency number).

As you may have heard, a grand jury recently indicted the defendant, who now faces fifteen charges (up from the original eleven). We've received requests to provide regular updates on the case, as so many parents understandably have a vested interested in the proceedings. Dr. Sylvester completed M.D. and Ph.D. (neuroscience) degrees in 2009, a general residency in psychiatry in 2012, and a fellowship in child and adolescent psychiatry in 2014, all at Washington University School of Medicine. Dr. Sylvester uses computer tasks and neuroimaging to study brain function in youth and infants to better understand anxiety disorders.
