

Safe & Inclusive Spaces, Week Four

Tillman began a four week, school-wide book study last month to discuss belonging and racism with our students. The entire school hears the same read-aloud on morning announcements each week, and then classroom teachers facilitate age-appropriate discussions centered around the same question. This work is necessary, at least in part, to address an unfortunate increase we've seen in the use of racial slurs and hurtful language.



- Our first read aloud was <u>A Kids Book About Belonging</u>, with all
 classes discussing the question, "What can you do to make
 everyone feel they belong at Tillman?"
- Our second read aloud was <u>Our Skin</u>, with all classes discussing the question, "How do we honor every individual at Tillman?"
- Last week all students heard the book, <u>A Kids Book About Racism</u> and discussed the question, "How does racism make it harder to belong?"
- For our fourth read aloud, students will hear an excerpt from <u>The Antiracist Kid</u> and discuss the question, "How can you be a positive change for the Tillman Community?"

Families can continue to reinforce this important work by talking to your Trailblazer about honoring the dignity of individuals and rejecting hate. If you have any questions, please contact Mr. Hoover or Dr. Painter.

Panorama Family Survey








