Parent-Teacher Conferences

Parent-teacher conferences are scheduled for this week, with most taking place on Tuesday and Thursday evening. While September's intake conferences leaned heavily on your voice and insights, you can expect to hear more this round from our teachers about student strengths, potential challenges and goals, and what to expect over the next few months. Our goal is always 100% participation, so please let us know if circumstances may require special arrangements for any of your conferences.

- As a reminder, eight classrooms (all third grade + Corr, Fehl, Schuler, & Taylor) are now located in our new wing. Ms. Rose has also moved, as have our counselors.
- Please note that our art, music, and PE teachers will also be holding drop-in conferences in their classrooms. They LOVE meeting with families and talking about kids, so please don't hesitate to visit them - especially if you have any questions or concerns.
- We hope you'll visit our new library and the Book Fair, located on the main floor of the new wing.
- While you're on campus, please check out the extensive Lost & Found (see video below) and
 use the wall space outside the library to add your ideas to our visual maps about enhancing
 STEAM learning for all students and closing gender and racial gaps in science, technology,
 engineering, art/design, and math.

- We are watching the weather for Tuesday and will make adjustments, as necessary, to ensure the safety of our staff and families.

Fourth Friday Celebrations

As mentioned in the introduction, we value having our families on campus and in our classrooms in ways that are meaningful and safe to all involved. We're excited to roll out one specific

opportunity for engagement this semester, with our new "Fourth Friday" events.

- On the Fourth Friday of each month, starting on January 26, we are inviting parents, family
 members, and other guests to read, play math games, or do design tasks with our Trailblazers.
 We're starting with reading, likely for the first few months, and we hope you'll join us to share
 in our love of books. No tests, no quizzes just good books shared among friends as we
 start our day together.
- Additional parking will be available behind Tillman on these mornings, and our doors will open at 8:20 to help us manage ID stickers and security. All students and guests will be invited into classrooms at our normal 8:25 arrival time. The tardy bell rings at 8:40.
- We will read until approximately 8:50, at which time families are invited to watch our live announcements from classrooms.
- Families will be <u>strongly</u> urged to register in advance, and we'll have stations at each door set up to gather your pre-printed ID stickers. More information will be provided about this soon.
- After our announcements have concluded, family members and guests are invited to enjoy light refreshments and good conversation in the cafeteria, courtesy of our PTO.

Ribbon Cutting & Open House

We're excited to invite all members of our Tillman Family and the broader KSD community to our official Ribbon Cutting & Open House on **Saturday, February 3** at 9am. More information will be coming soon, but we wanted to share the date as soon as possible. In addition to a ribbon cutting, guests will have the opportunity to tour the building and see our new and repurposed spaces.



STEAM in education refers to an intentional focus on using Science, Technology, Engineering, Art/Design, and Mathematics as access points for guiding student inquiry, dialogue, and critical thinking. STEAM broadens the focus of STEM by including art/design and recognizing the importance of creativity, design processes, and iterative thinking. We want all students, boys and girls, to excel in STEAM-related subjects and with STEAM-related tasks. Just as important, we want our boys and girls to value math, science, technology, engineering, and principles of art/design AND believe in their abilities to be successful in these areas, even when - especially when - the tasks are challenging.

There are a number of racial and gender gaps in our data, across multiple disciplines, but none stands out more than what we've seen specific to math and science - the STEAM fields most frequently assessed. Addressing STEAM gaps is one of several district-wide areas of focus, and we'd like to engage families as partners in eliminating these gaps.
