


Changes to Arrival & Dismissal Routines

Our morning arrival & afternoon dismissal routines are being moved to the rear of the building, similar to pre-construction routines, to enhance safety and alleviate traffic backups on Quan and neighboring streets. These changes will begin on **Monday**, **January 22**. Morning drop-off will be along the southeast curb of our newest wing, with students entering via the new entrance in that area. Afternoon pickup will include two loops of vehicles lined up inside the gates of our blacktop. Please review the maps shown below (also included on <u>our website</u>), and watch for adults directing traffic before and after school. Seventy-five people have preregistered as of this writing, and we expect to have 100+ guests in attendance. For online registration, it is recommended that a laptop computer, desktop computer or tablet device be used to complete your child's registration. Registration using a smartphone is not recommended.

Legal Information: Trunk or Treat Update

We understand that some families may wish for ongoing information related to our Trunk or Treat event, particularly updates on the defendant's legal proceedings and whereabouts after his release on bond. As was mentioned in Dr. Ulrich's email on January 2, there were numerous conditions and terms included in his bond reduction, including treatment in a locked mental health facility followed by home detention with electronic monitoring of his whereabouts at all times. The defendant is also not permitted, under any circumstances, to be within 1,000 feet of the City of Kirkwood or any schools within our district. In addition, the judge took the extraordinary step of requiring the psychiatric center and the monitoring service to alert her immediately and personally if the defendant is not where he is ordered to be. If that should occur, the prosecutor's office will be notified, and the prosecutor will in turn alert the Kirkwood Police Department and KSD administration, including our Director of Safety & Security.

The defendant has recently completed requirements at the mental health facility and was discharged for monitored home detention in a St. Charles County residence. This information may understandably generate anxiety and concern for some within our community, especially those who were in attendance at the event. While we cannot know where the defendant will be at all times, we have assurances we will be notified if he is not where he is allowed to be. This information will be shared quickly with those charged with protecting our community and our schools. We hope this brings you some comfort.

As for updates on legal proceedings, your best source of information will likely be the Victim's Advocate and Prosecuting Attorney in the prosecutor's office. Their emails are included below.
